Introduction

This is a summary of OTF investments for the second granting cycle of the 2017/18 fiscal year.

In the report below, all historical comparisons are against Grow streams in the 2015/2016 and 2016/17 fiscal years, unless otherwise indicated. The choice of these cycles is intended to produce an “apples-to-apples” comparison of cycles containing only the Grow Stream.

Schedule 1: Executive Summary Community Investments

1.1 Highlight: Significantly more grants benefitting equity-seeking populations

Recommended investments to several equity-seeking populations have increased this cycle. At 5.6% of OTF’s overall recommended investments this cycle, recommendations for grants benefitting Francophones **are more than double** the average of the previous 2 fiscal years.

Recommendations benefitting LGBTTTQ+ and People with Disabilities also saw sizable increases. Recommendations for grants to LGBTTTQ+ communities increased from 2.1% to 3.4% of OTF overall, while recommendations to People with Disabilities increased from 13.2% to 19.9%.

1.2 Cycle Summary: Grow Investment Stream

We received **625 applications** requesting **\$225.8M**. Of these applications, a total of **134** for **\$49.56M** are recommended for approval. We expect that within the next 36 months, the recommended investments will impact more than **373,000 Ontarians**.

The new Investment Strategy continues to enable **larger and deeper grants** to be made. In fact, the average grant (\$369,864) in this cycle is larger than it was in the previous two fiscal years. This represents an **12% increase** over the average grant size of \$330,030 we saw in the last two fiscal years.

We continue to track several results to understand trends in internal and external understanding of and engagement with the investment strategy.

- Technical Declines – 82% of all applications received were technically eligible for OTF funds, a 10-percentage point increase from the last two fiscal years.
- Volunteer scoring – Volunteers are showing continued high engagement, with 82% of volunteers scoring all assigned files.

While these indicators show strong levels of understanding and engagement with the new Investment Strategy, we are continually seeking to improve. The Evaluation team, Strategy Leads, Communications Department, and Sector Capacity Program Managers are continuing to work together to deliver enhanced support and training to potential applicants. These efforts combined with continual Staff and Volunteer learning opportunities ensure we improve our ratio of good applications and build knowledge about our investment strategy amongst our Program Managers and GRT members. With more insight gleaned from our data model, these outreach and training sessions can become more targeted and impactful.

1.3 Action Area Summaries and Noteworthy Grants

Active People

Recommendations in the Active People Action Area are expected to foster active healthy lifestyles for more than **12,000 Ontarians** of all ages and abilities. Initiatives for individuals that typically have barriers to participation and lower physical activity rates were particularly prevalent this round. Recommendations support programs targeting older adults, women, low-income families, people with early stage dementia, and Ontarians living with disabilities.

A recommended grant that embodies this trend is for the implementation of the StrongWomen Program administered by the RA Centre in Ottawa. Building on a highly successful U.S. model, StrongWomen is an evidence-based community exercise program targeting mid-life and older women. The program employs two distinct components; the first is a strength training curriculum that helps maintain muscle mass, strength and function as they age, the second is a heart health curriculum focusing on aerobic activity. The program will train more than 30 program leaders and move 540 women to become active, fit, strong and healthy.

Connected People

About **19,480 Ontarians** will be impacted by OTF recommendations to reduce social isolation and bring the diversity in our communities together. For the 2017 Grow cycle, OTF is recommending \$11.1 million in 29 projects accounting for 22% of OTF recommendations.

A persistent trend within the Action Area is the focus on addressing social isolation. While this is a commonly held goal by many organizations and communities, approaches and populations impacted vary greatly across the board. OTF's recommendations in pilots and testing through the SEED

grants continues to be a strong source of evidence for several notable projects in this round building on successful tests and research of their approaches.

One recommendation of note is the \$300,000 recommendation in Volunteer Sudbury's Valuable Volunteer Program (VVP) aimed at reducing social isolation among people with disabilities and suffering from mental illness by creating meaningful volunteer opportunities for them and breaking down organizational barriers they face when looking to participate. This project will connect at least 425 persons with disabilities to meaningful volunteer opportunities in the Greater Sudbury Area.

Green People

Recommended investments in the Green People Action Area this cycle will impact the lives of **over 81,000 Ontarians** by helping to support a healthy and sustainable environment. Projects address both Priority Outcomes – helping to ensure that ecosystems are conserved and restored, and that people reduce their impact on the environment – and represent 10% of recommendations this Grow cycle.

Several projects supported this cycle address the urgent need to restore degraded ecosystems, important for enhancing wildlife habitat, improving soil and water quality, and a myriad of other benefits. For example, with OTF support, the Nature Conservancy of Canada will significantly expand restoration of endangered tallgrass prairie and oak savanna across 360 hectares of the Rice Lake Plains in Northumberland County. These native habitats have been vastly diminished across North America, with only about 1% remaining. Some of the best remaining examples and opportunities for restoration exist in Ontario's Rice Lake Plains.

Recognizing the significant threats to shoreline ecosystems and the value these provide to biodiversity and people, Watersheds Canada will launch a new shoreline restoration program across Renfrew County over 25 hectares of degraded shoreline, based on its proven restoration model successfully implemented elsewhere. Both projects are underpinned by sound science and restoration planning, and involve active engagement of the local community and landowners to ensure success.

Inspired People

OTF recommends \$7,616,600 in 23 projects in the Inspired People Action Area this cycle. Of that amount, 54% will fund increasing access to arts based learning and compelling artistic, cultural and heritage experiences, 17% will fund engagement in community-based arts creation, and 29% will fund the preservation and animation of cultural heritage. These recommendations are expected to enrich the lives of over **190,000 Ontarians** through arts, culture and heritage.

A notable example of a recommendation in increasing access to arts-based learning is being led by CultureLink Settlement and Community Services in Toronto. Through a 3-year investment of \$724,500, the Nai Choir Project will provide free and accessible music education to more than 700 refugee children from Syria and other war-torn countries of the Middle East using music as a mobilizing force for healing, hope and connection. notable example of an investment in the preservation and animation of cultural heritage is being led by the Moose Cree First Nation in ACMS. Through a 3-year investment of \$502,800, Moose Cree First Nation will increase access to cultural teachings through arts, traditional food preparation, land based activities and gatherings ensuring that knowledge is transferred from Elders and Traditional Knowledge Keepers to more than 470 community members.

Promising Young People

Over **33,000 people** are expected to benefit from recommended investments in Promising Young People this granting cycle. Projects continue to support youth facing barriers, including newcomer, racialized, youth in care, LGBTTQ+, and low-income youth, amongst others. Several initiatives recommended this cycle also support young people to become agents of change and address social issues that matter to them, such as racism and illiteracy. Young people across Ontario are supported in designing, leading and implementing initiatives in their schools and communities.

It is interesting to note that the current grow cycle has seen a few projects go to scale based on new practice based evidence generated from previously funded Seed projects. For instance, the Visions of Science Network Learning scaled their STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) clubs to impact 600 more Toronto children and youth as evidence they had generated through a Seed grant revealed that their approach and practice increased social emotional skills, such as self-awareness and relationship skills, of low income youth by 60%.

Notable recommendations this Grow cycle addressed unique challenges faced by youth with disabilities such as autism, down syndrome and other physical and cognitive disabilities. These projects support the development of strong social emotional skills of children and youth.

One such recommended investment will improve the social emotional skills of over 400 children and youth aged 11-18 with autism. The Geneva Centre for Autism Foundation will be delivering the Program for the Education and Enrichment of Relational Skills (PEERS) in multiple locations across the GTA. PEERS is the only available evidence-based social skills program for adolescents and adults with autism. Social skill deficits are a core feature of autism and have an enormous effect on children's mental health and wellbeing. 50% of adolescents with autism report having no friends at all. PEERS was developed at UCLA and rigorous evaluation, including randomized control trials, revealed significant improvements in overall social skills in the areas such as social communication, social cognition, social awareness, social motivation, assertion, cooperation and responsibility.

Prosperous People

In this granting cycle, OTF recommendations in Prosperous people will impact the lives of over **36,000 Ontarians** in vulnerable situations, notably women, youth, immigrants, and people with disabilities. Many of these projects address employment, food security, and financial literacy, thereby improving the quality of life, stability and health of low-income individuals and families across Ontario.

For example, OTF's recommended investment to WIL Employment Connections expands two of its existing "Immploy Online" employment initiatives focused on improving the economic well-being of 320 additional immigrant job seekers across Southwestern Ontario. Through strategic employer leadership and partner collaborations, Immploy connects employers with immigrant talent, offering dedicated screening, job matching, and recruitment services. As well, there is a mentorship component which connects immigrant job seekers (mentees) with regional business leaders (mentors) from their occupation/industry. This multi-pronged approach addresses both the demand and supply side of employment which are instrumental in effectively meeting the needs of both employer and employee. It also provides ongoing coaching for the job seeker, thereby increasing the likelihood of sustained employment.

1.4 Sign-Offs

Sign-Off from Chairs: Each GRT Chair had signed off on the final list of grants recommended by the GRT.

Compliance with OTF Policy: The Vice-President, Community Investments has reviewed granting policy compliance. The VP, Community Investments confirms that all recommended grants are within the granting policies of the Foundation.

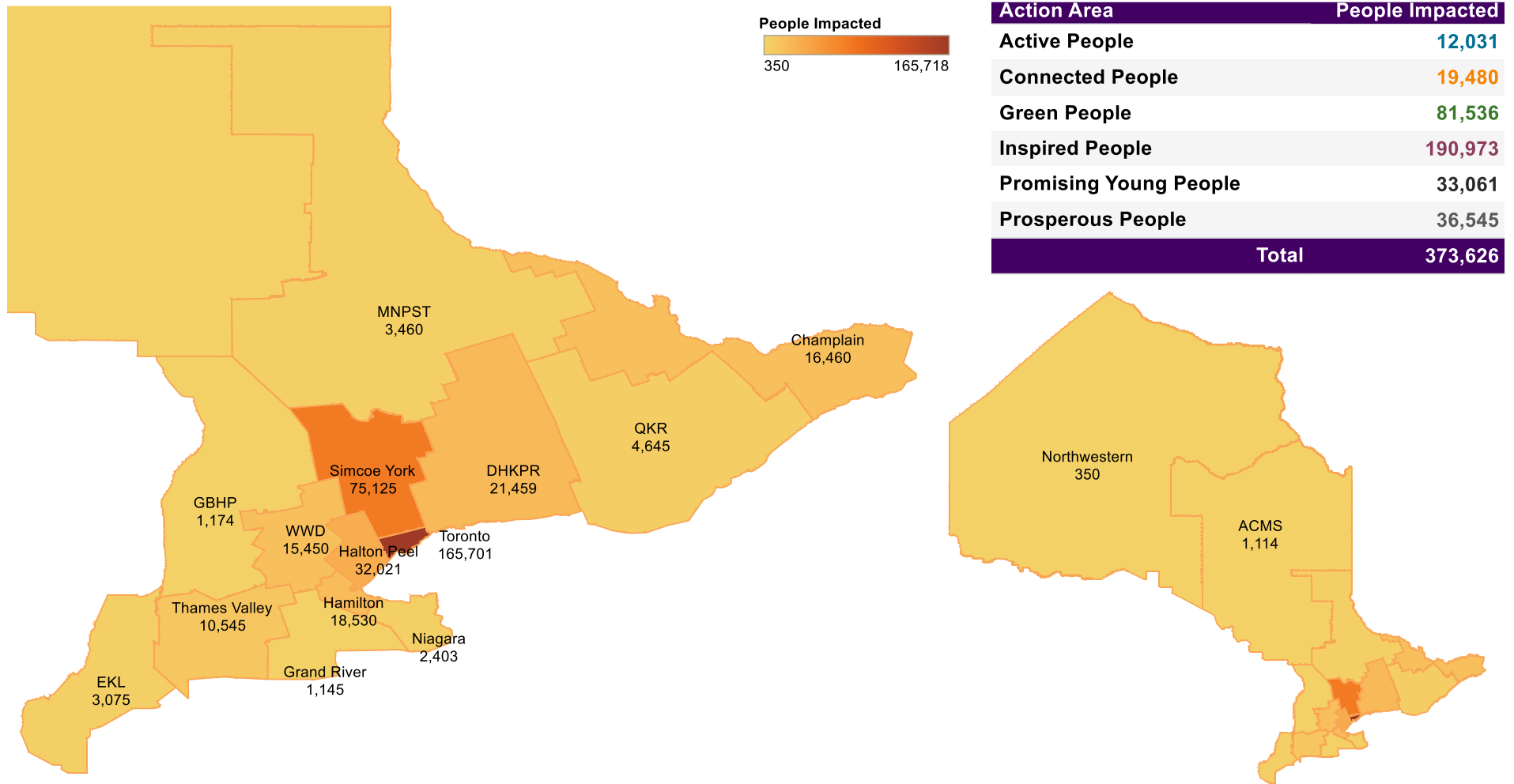

2.1 People Impacted in next 3 years through Grow Grants

Within the next one to three years, we expect more than **373,000** Ontarians will be impacted by initiatives funded by OTF this cycle. Notably, over **190,000 Ontarians** will experience artistic programs and works, and over **81,000** will take deliberate actions to benefit the environment. The majority of people impacted live in central Ontario, where nearly 290,000 people will benefit from recommended OTF-funded initiatives.

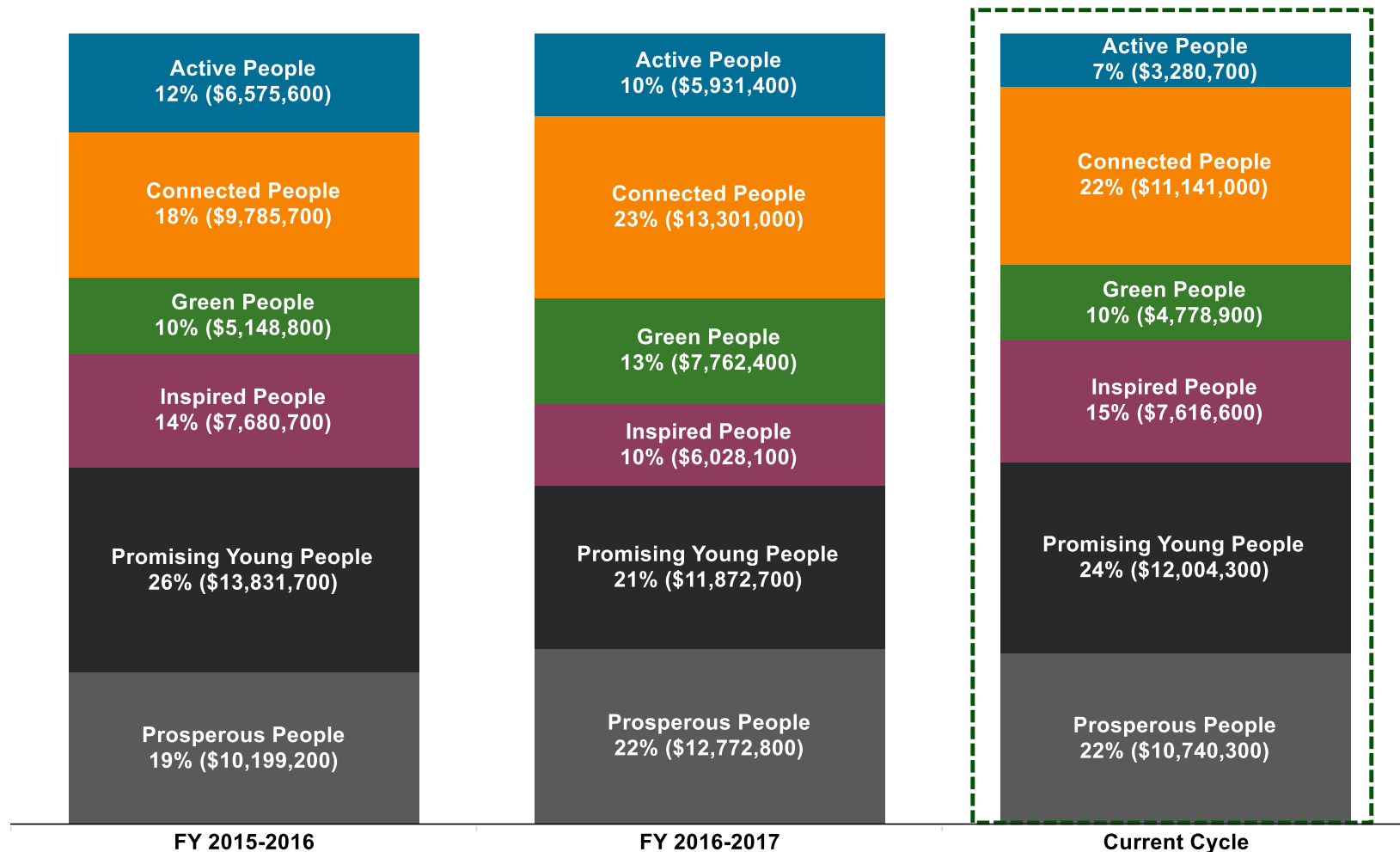

2.2 Action Area Overview

Recommended investments across Action Areas are relatively stable from previous fiscal years. The exception is Active People, which, at 7%, continues to see a downward trend in recommendations from previous years; these levels are commensurate with its proportion of overall requests. Recommendations for Green People are lower than the previous year. However, at 8% of requests and 10% of recommendations, this Action Area continues to be funded at a high rate. Inspired People saw an increase in recommendations (15% of OTF overall), also commensurate with dollar requests for the Action Area.



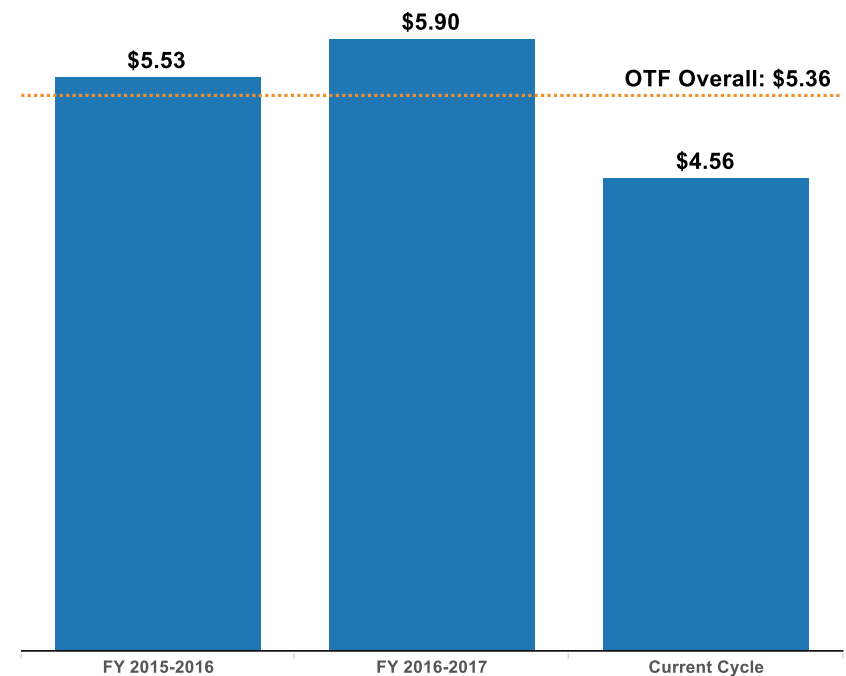
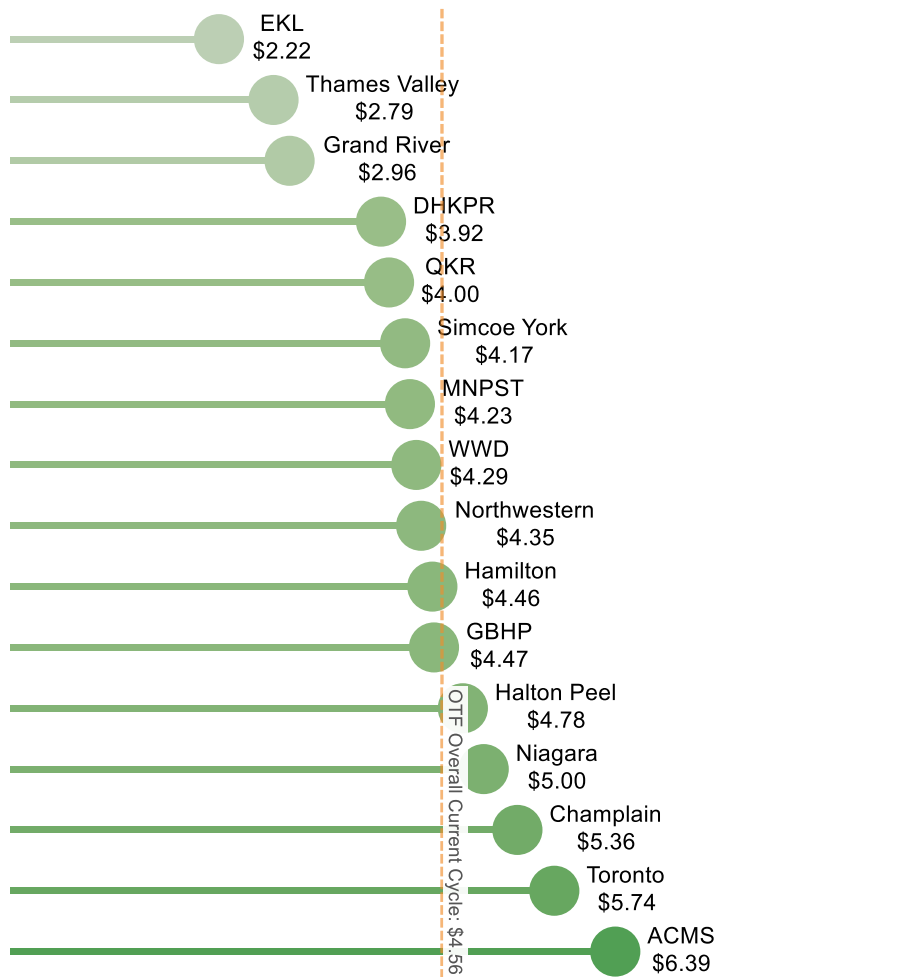

2.3 Application Demand

Demand in the current cycle is **\$4.56 per dollar requested**, a decrease from previous years. This level reflects OTF's restored funding budget, as well as fewer and more targeted applications that reflect an improved understanding of the Investment Strategy (as evidenced by the lower technical decline rate). Catchments in Southwestern Ontario generally saw lower demand for funding. This was especially notable in Essex Kent Lambton, Grand River, and Thames Valley, where 1 in every 2 to 3 dollars of requests were funded, well below the OTF average.

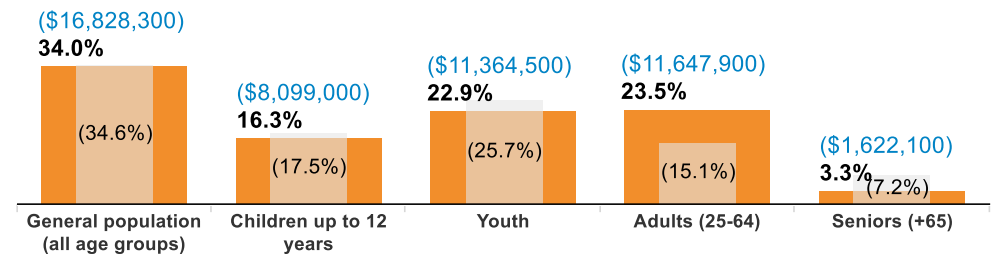
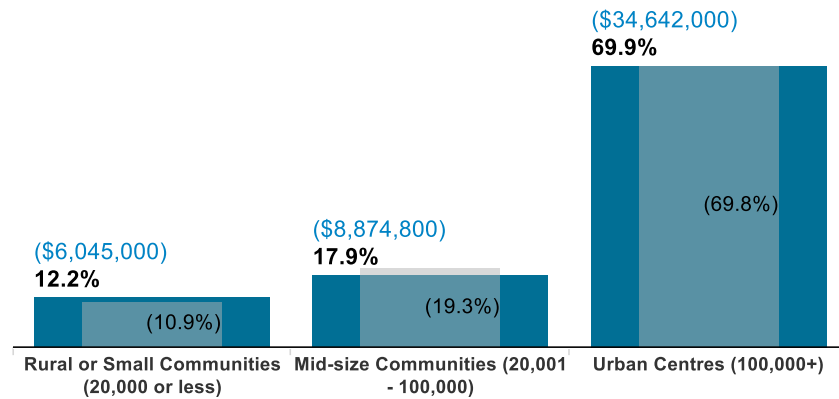

2.4.1 Investment Equity – Populations

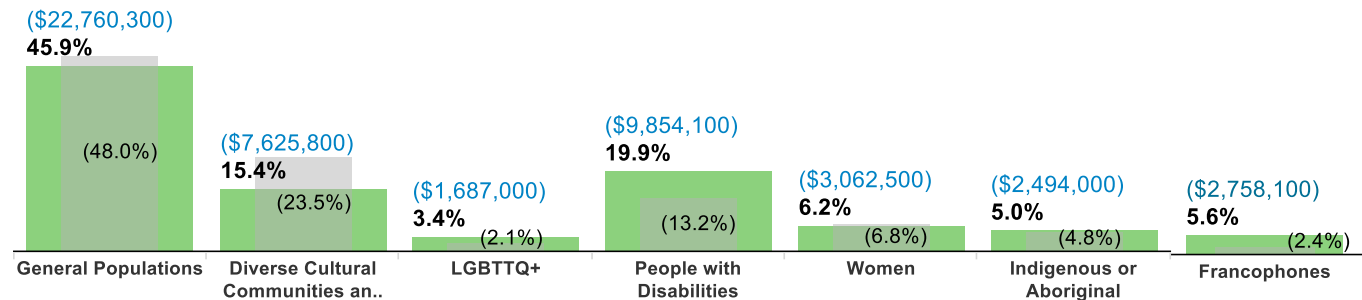
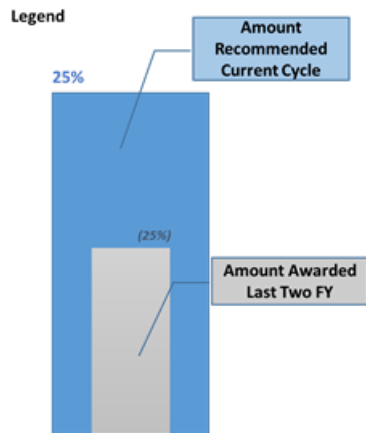
Recommended investments benefiting the Francophone community and the LGBTTTQ+ community are higher this cycle. **Francophone recommendations are 5.6% of total recommendations** this cycle, a **233% increase from previous years**. LGBTTTQ+ investments are 3.4% of total investments, a 62% increase. These gains support the efficacy of recent efforts to target outreach and supports to these communities, as well as to improve staff and volunteer understanding through experiential learning and training.

Recommended Dollars By Population Served

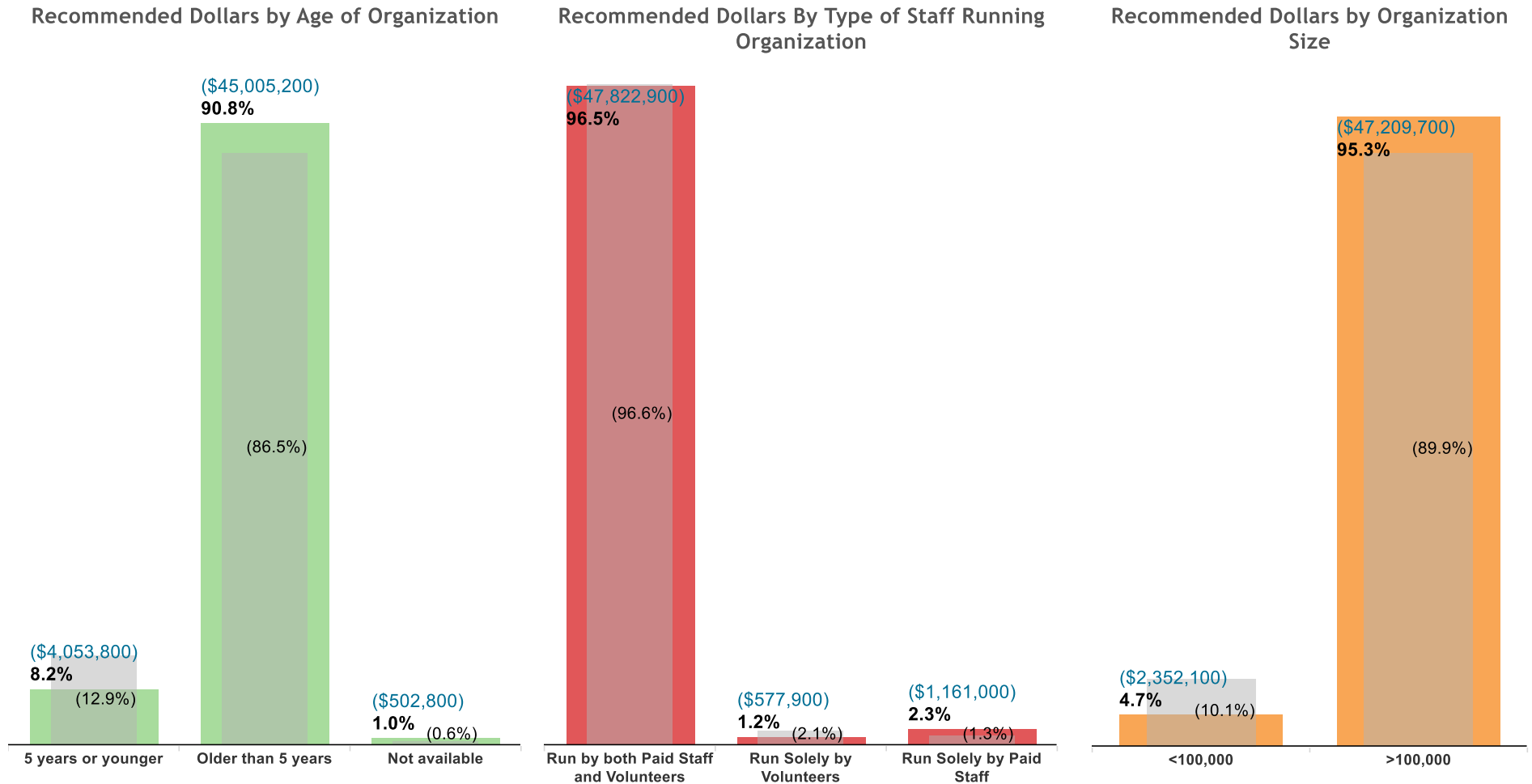

2.4.2 Investment Equity – Organizations

Continuing a trend from previous cycles, more-established and larger organizations received a greater share of recommended investments this cycle. This can be seen in a 36% reduction in recommendations to organizations 5 years and younger, and a 53% reduction in recommendations to organizations with less than \$100,000 in annual revenue. It is unclear whether this ongoing shift reflects the natural course of organizations in the sector maturing and becoming more established over time, or if OTF's emphasis on outcomes in the Grow stream selects for programs run by more established, higher capacity organizations.



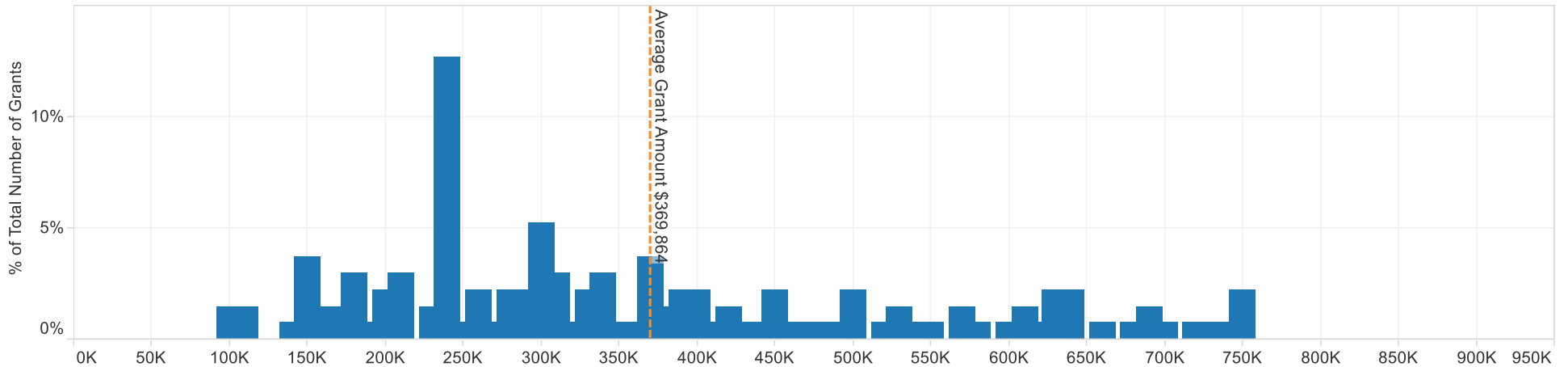

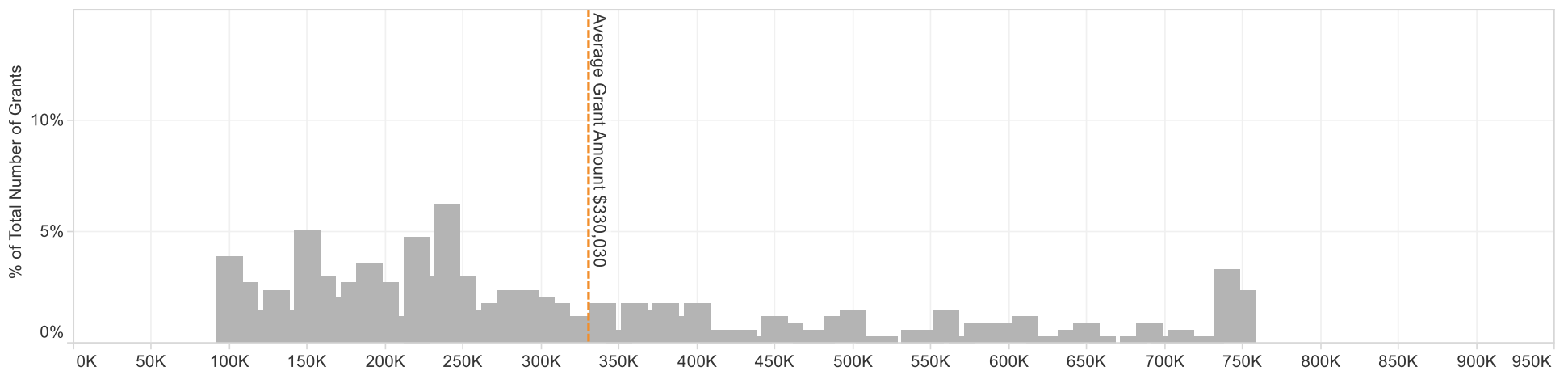
2.5 Larger, Deeper Grants – Grant Size

The new Investment Strategy continues to achieve one of its key goals towards larger and deeper grants. The average grant size this cycle is \$369,864, up 12% from the last two fiscal years' average of \$330,030. This increase is driven by fewer small grants being recommended, and a higher volume of grants in the mid-range (especially around \$250,000), as well as increases across the board in mid-size and large grants up to \$750,000.

3.0 Concluding Remarks

This OTF Investment Summary Report outlines key highlights and insights from this cycle of recommended investments. It provides context to the data so that we can continue to make informed decisions on how best to make high-impact grants that serve the diverse needs of Ontario communities. With over \$47M in recommended investments, the impact of this cycle is expected to be felt by nearly **374,000 Ontarians**, many of whom live in communities that have historically been underserved. This includes over **190,000 people who will take part in art, cultural and heritage experiences**, over **81,000 who will take deliberate actions to benefit the environment**, and over **36,000 who will experience enhanced economic wellbeing**. With fewer technical declines and increased recommendations to priority populations, these results speak to the strengths of OTF's commitment to continuous learning and improvement on its mission to build healthy and vibrant communities across the province.
